MAJESTIC TURF FESCUE SOD® SPECIFICATIONS

Professionally produced, cultivated and installed by Campbell Sod Inc. of Rossville, Kansas, a Commercial Sod Producer. 5147 NW Boyd Road, Rossville, KS. 785-584-6050, Attn: Mike McMillin.

The blend of seed used for producing MAJESTIC TURF FESCUE will be highly rated by the National Turf Grass Evaluation Program (NTEP) and show high performance in the Midwest reporting stations of Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma and Nebraska.

The seed mix used for MAJESTIC TURF FESCUE will consist of

90% (+/-) of an improved Turf Type Tall Fescue Blend (minimum of 3 varieties)

10% (+/-) of an improved variety of Kentucky bluegrass.

Gold Tag Certified Seed

Sod Fields will be seeded, cultivated, irrigated and professionally managed. MAJESTIC TURF FESCUE SOD will be mowed frequently at a height of 1.5". During production of the fields, pest management procedures will include, weed control, fungicide applications and insect monitoring and controlling to maintain high quality turfgrass.

Soil thickness of sod at delivery may differ from time to time. As a general rule, MAJESTIC TURF FESCUE SOD will have approximately 3/8" of soil. Sod will be grown on native loam topsoil and compatible with Midwest soils.

Characteristics required prior to harvest of MAJESTIC TURF FESCUE SOD

- Adequate sod strength for harvesting and handling
- Excellent turfgrass color
- High shoot density and uniformity
- Sufficient soil moisture
- Show signs of sufficient maturity at harvest
- Free of noxious weeds and grasses

At delivery, sod will be freshly cut from the field within 24 hours, in healthy condition and with sufficient moisture.

SOD INSTALLATION

- Installation will be overseen by a manager of Campbell Sod Inc.
- Area will be completely graded and free of rock, grass and any debris that would hinder the placement of sod
- Underground sprinklers, valve boxes and any other buried components must be flagged prior to installation
- Site inspection by a representative of Campbell Sod Inc. prior to shipment is suggested.

SOD INSTALLATION

- “Pre-Watering” may be required prior to installation. A Campbell Sod Inc. representative may be consulted to determine timing and quantity of irrigation
- Sod will be professionally installed by Campbell Sod Inc. in accordance with specifications and using approved equipment
- Sod will be placed carefully to provide full coverage, (seams will be unnoticeable)
- On steep slopes it may be necessary to “pin” the sod down, using steel staples or wooden dowels
- Final approval by the owners representative will be provided prior to departure from the site
- Irrigation should begin immediately after installation

MAJESTIC TURF FESCUE SOD may be ordered and delivered in the following configurations:

NETTING

- With or without netting. (Netting is installed in the field at seeding of Fescue Sod) Some applications, such as athletic fields may request sod without netting

ROLL SIZES

- Standard Roll: 18” Wide x 6’ long (1 Square Yard) - 50 square yards per pallet/20 pallets (1,000 yards per truckload) Also can cut standard roll at 21”Wide x 62” long
- Big Rolls: 3.5’ wide, up to 50 yards per roll.
- Mini Rolls: 21” wide x 5 yards per roll.

WASHED (SOIL-LESS) SOD

- Washed, soil-less sod available in the Majestic Turf Fescue Sod, Majestic Bluegrass Sod or by any specifications
- Washed sod will be harvested and have the same characteristics as above
- Sod will be washed using an approved sod washing machine that maintains proper pressure and volume of water to properly remove the soil. 90% (+/-) of all soil will be removed, and done in a manner that does not damage or tear the sod
- The finish product of washed sod will be rolled, delivered and installed by qualified installers

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Sod will be produced within 250 miles from the site of installation
- A tour of the sod field by the Owners Representative
- Sod will be produced by a member of the Turfgrass Producers International (TPI)
- Contractor will make a submittal of seed blend used to produce sod to include varieties, purity, germination and weed/crop content
- The owner’s representative will have the right to accept or reject sod at any time during the contract period.
